

TC article receives more than 28,000 views

Article level metrics provide an alternative means of assessing the impact of a paper compared to the more familiar citation indices. For policy-relevant papers or ones which have a public interest they are in many ways a more instructive measure of the impact of the work. Since August 2013, a paper on [Himalayan Glacier mass balance](#) has received more than 28,000 downloads and views. This clearly demonstrates the power and reach of the Open Access model that EGU journals have adopted. We encourage authors to check the ALMs for their papers and to consider using this information as an alternative measure of impact.
